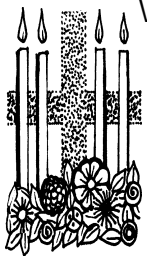

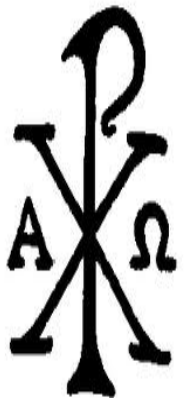

THE NEW MISSAL

Next Sunday marks a significant step in the journey towards full use of the new edition of the Roman Missal on the First Sunday of Advent. From next Sunday onwards, together with most other parishes in Ireland, we will begin to use the People's Prayers and Responses from the New Missal. This will include the new translations of the following texts: the people's response to the greeting by the priest (And with your spirit); the Confiteor, the Gloria, the Apostles' Creed and the Acclamations for the Eucharistic Prayer as well as the text for the invitation to Communion. It is important to remember that this is not a new Mass and there are no changes to the structure of the Mass. It is a new, more accurate and richer translation of the Roman Missal. Please God, it will help us grow in faith, in worship and in prayer, and give us a deeper appreciation of the liturgy we celebrate.
