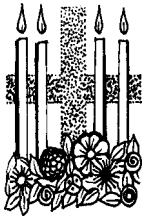

them now, be attentive to what that

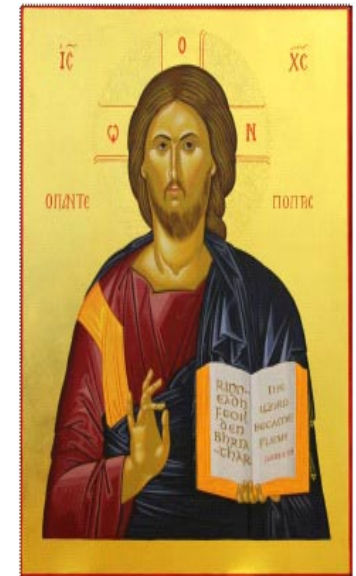
hearing evokes in you .
