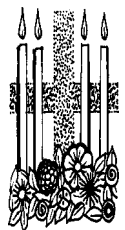

At the Last Supper Jesus left us a wonderful legacy of love and sacrifice. It continues in the Masses celebrated all over the world today. In the Eucharist Jesus offers us his body and blood for our nourishment under the signs of bread and wine. 'And as they were eating he took some bread, and when he had said the blessing he broke it and gave it to them.

'Take it,' he said 'this is my body.'  
Then he took a cup, and when he had returned thanks he gave it to them, and all drank from it, and he said to them, 'This is my blood, the blood of the new covenant, which is to be poured out for many'.
