He has gone before us.

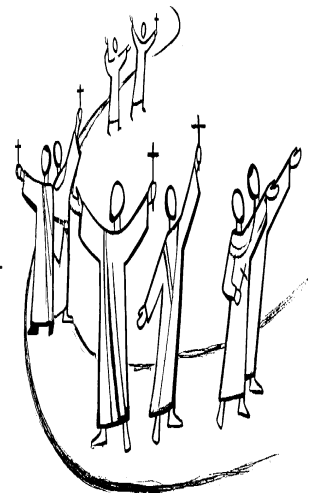
For the time being.
